
## Sewer Taps Available for Purchase...

The Town has limited number of sewer taps available for sale to property owners in areas presently serviced by sewer. The Force Main line runs down Highway 165 and accessing some side roads off Highway 165, portions of Ethel Post Office Road (closer to Highway 165) and most of Archfield Subdivision.

If you live in these areas and are interested in purchasing a sewer tap, please visit the [Town Hall](#) or call [Charleston Water Systems](#) to verify if your property can tap into the sewer system.

Sewer Taps are \$4000.00 each and can be bought 1 per TMS# every 90 days per property owner until they are all purchased. The Town encourages anyone interested in purchasing a sewer tap to read [Sewer Ordinance 2012-02](#) and contact the Town with any questions.

Owners of sewer taps that are not in use will have a quarterly charge of \$45.00 billed from the Town. Sewer taps that are tapped into the sewer line will receive monthly bills from CWS.

Please encourage your




**Sincere Apologies...**
